



VBSLSC Bunkhouse Rules Policy

1. All members wishing to stay in the bunkhouse are required to sign the club indemnity/waiver prior to the commencement of the season.
2. All overnight stays (i.e. after 10pm and before 7am) in thebunkhouse are to be entered daily into the bunkhouse log.
3. Payment of bunkhouse fees is to be made either to the property manager or the Treasurer. Fees are \$50 for the season or \$10 per night. Bunkhouse fees are waived for members on the night beforeor after patrol.
4. Payment is required before commencement of the patrolling season.
5. No overnight stay is permitted if the bunkhouse fees have not beenpaid.
6. Smoking and the consumption of alcohol and drugs are not permittedin the Bunkhouse.
7. Only VBSLSC members and lifeguards are permitted to enter the bunkhouse rooms unless written permission is obtained from the property manager or committee prior to the intended stay.
8. Only males are permitted to stay in the bunkhouse room designatedfor males, and only females are permitted to stay in the bunkhouse room designated for females.
9. Members aged under 18 must have a parent/ guardian stay with them in the bunkhouse. In the event that this is not possible, identification of a responsible person aged 18 or over must be madein writing, ensuring the junior member is in the care of a responsibleadult club member who is present in the club at the time of the overnight stay.
10. Users of the bunkhouse are expected to act considerately to others by maintaining the cleanliness of the bunkhouse and keeping noise toreasonable levels.
11. Damage to facilities and equipment failure must be reported to the property manager as soon as possible. Individuals will be held personally responsible for expenses incurred to repair damage that isdeemed to be caused through carelessness or malice.
12. The bunkhouse, kitchen and bathrooms are to be kept clean and tidy,rubbish is to be disposed of.



13. The property manager and committee members are authorised to request club members and non-members to exit the bunkhouse.
14. Non-adherence to the bunkhouse rules is subject to disciplinary action as decided by the committee.
15. The Bunkhouse rules will be monitored and enforced by the property manager and committee members.
16. Any exceptional circumstances that do not adhere to the rules set out in this document must be approved by the property manager in advance, in the first instance, and by the committee if the property manager deems it necessary.
17. Any breach of this agreement may result in the cancellation of the individual's right to stay in the bunkhouse.

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
