



VENUS BAY SLSC HARDSHIP POLICY

VBSLSC offers services, social connections and programs for people of all ages, cultural backgrounds and abilities and further recognises that not all people can afford to contribute financially. An integral part of our mission is to provide equal access to our services, therefore members experiencing financial difficulty may be eligible for either a fee reduction or waiver (“hardship application”).

To apply, members should write in the first instance to the Secretary, providing supporting documentation.

Applications will be reviewed by the Club President, Treasurer, Secretary and Membership Officer. The Club may request further information in support of any hardship application.

The Club may, in its absolute discretion, offer to waive all or part of the member’s annual fee for that year.

The Club may request that in lieu of any waived fees or reduction, the member contributes to the Club in other ways.

Applications must be made on an annual basis.
