Venus Bay Surf Lifesaving Club and Life Saving Victoria are committed to the health, safety and wellbeing of all its members and is dedicated to providing a best practice approach to ensure a safe environment for those participating in lifesaving and club activities.

Life Saving Victoria is a unique organisation that has multiple purposes including community service, sporting, education and leadership opportunities and programs. Each of these individual aspects interrelate with each other. It is due to the multifaceted nature of lifesaving, that members 18 years of age who interact with children across a broad spectrum of activities are required to have a Working with Children Check (WWCC).

Applying for a WWCC as a volunteer is free and relatively straightforward. You can apply online at
